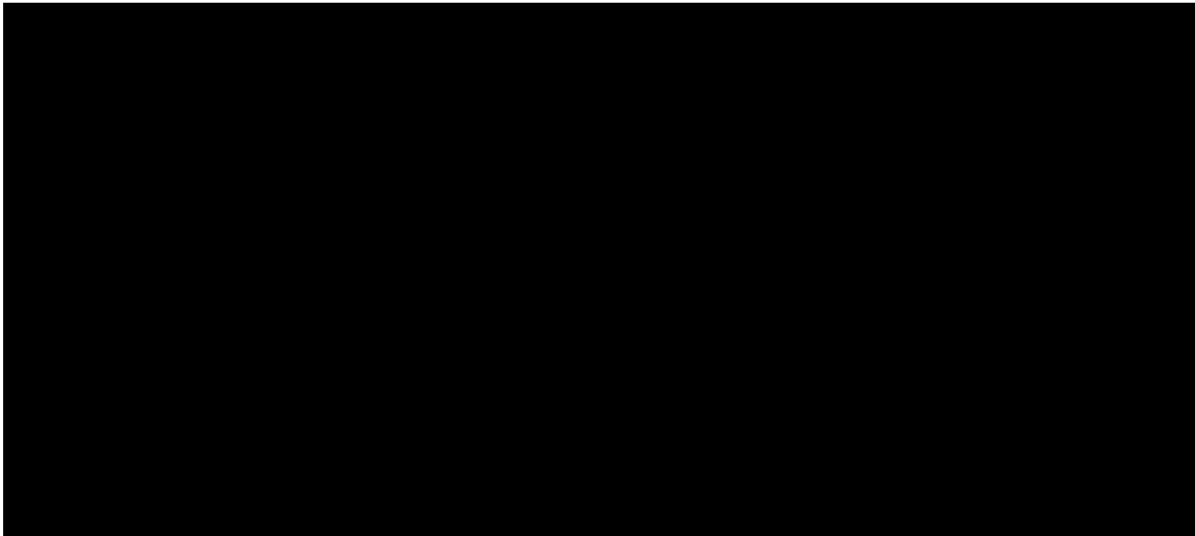
Supplementary Witness Statement of

1. My name is Joanne Peacher. My date of birth is 30 December, 1968. My contact details are known to the Inquiry.
2. I have already given a statement to the Scottish Child Abuse Inquiry, which I signed on 28 August, 2017.

 I was raped by a priest in Nazareth House about a week after the abuse I suffered from  LFV I was about nine years old at the time. He was in his early thirties. I don't know his name. I can't remember him saying anything to me. He walked into my room and raped me. Although I shared a room with two other girls, they weren't in the room. I can't remember their names. I was alone at the time. I had a broken ankle and German measles. The two girls and I

spoke to each other about being raped, but we never told anybody because we were too scared.

6. I had not seen the priest before he raped me. I saw him a couple of times after this. I was in the grounds and I saw him walking into the main part of the children's home. I had reported the rape to the police [REDACTED]
The outcome of this report was that the police informed me they would need the names of the other two girls before they could proceed further.
7. I have no objection to my witness statement being published as part of the evidence to the Inquiry. I believe the facts stated in this witness statement are true.
