- when I was in the bigger dormitory. The lights went out and then Brother walked up and down the dormitory. There were beds on either side of the dormitory and mine was on the right hand side as you went in. My bed was close to the door. I cannot remember whether it was right next to the door or whether it was one or two down. My friend, I think, was right next to me. Brother many came and

stood by my bed. I was laying on my stomach, and he lay on top of me on my back, with his face close to my face. Then he put his hand down my pants onto my penis and fondled it. I cannot recall precisely how long it lasted. But it was not for very long. He then said "I'll be back" and he left. Luckily for me, for whatever reason, that was the extent of it. He never came back. "

- goes on to describe Brother as being a young Brother who was a teacher. He thinks that he was a novice and was not at St Columba's College for very long. He also states that Brother had very red lips.
